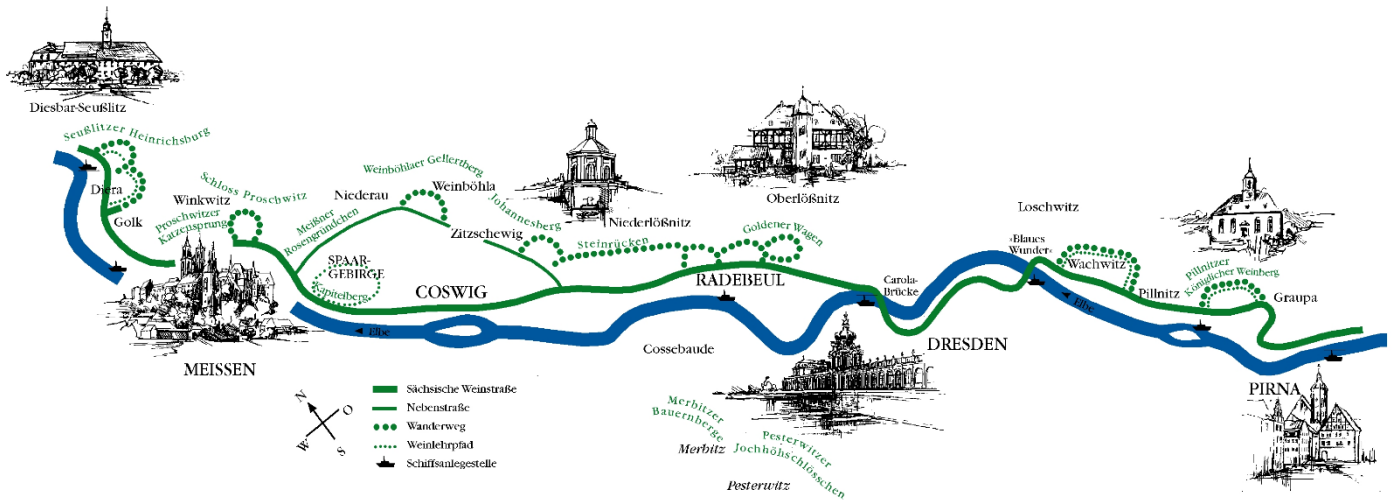
Sauvignon Blanc ~ dry

This year's vintage shows typical vegetal aromas of yellow and green peppers, as well as subtle herbaceous and exotic accents. On the palate, it is joined by a fresh acidity.

Unique in Saxony is the wine landscape. The wine-growing region - together with Jessen and Schlieben - on the Elbe is considered one of the smallest in Germany.

The 55 km long wine route from Pirna via Dresden, Radebeul and Meißen to the idyllic Elbe wine villages around Diesbar-Seußlitz harmoniously combines cultural-historical sights and the charming landscape shaped by over 850 years of viticulture. Culture, history, a fascinating river and wine landscape, porcelain and architecture - this close connection makes the Saxon wine-growing region so attractive and unique.

The wines grow on the slopes of the Elbe Valley on weathered granite and sandstone.

The area is divided into the Meissen, Dresden and Elstertal regions.

The soils are very diverse, ranging from weathered rock near Pillnitz, granite with loess overlays in the steep slopes of Meissen and Radebeul, red sandstone near Zadel, to loess loam and alluvial soils. The climate is rather dry and continental with partly cold winters and a clear risk of late frost as well as sometimes hot summers. Quality and quantity are therefore subject to probably the greatest fluctuations of all German wine-growing regions.

The relatively calcareous soils give the wines their special character: they are full of character, dry, with fruity acidity. The main variety is Müller-Thurgau, followed by Traminer and Weißer Burgunder. A Saxon specialty is the Goldriesling, which is found nowhere else in Germany.

Local viticulture has a long tradition. Grapes were already pressed in the Middle Ages, the oldest document dates back to 1161. The first viticultural school in Europe opened in Meissen in 1811. At that time, the area under cultivation measured over 1500 hectares. Due to wars and pest infestation, it shrank to 70ha by the middle of the 20th century. In the meantime, however, it is again approaching 500 ha - with an upward trend.
